
## INVENTIONS

The period of time during which Leonardo lived was called the **Renaissance**. To be highly esteemed in those days, one was expected to be **well-rounded**, **accomplished in many different areas**. Because of Leonardo's great variety of talents, he is considered to be one of the great men of the Renaissance, and he is often referred to as "the Renaissance Man."

As well as being an **artist**, a **mathematician**, a **mountain climber**, an **astronomer** and an **architect**, Leonardo also **created many inventions**. He is said to have been constantly drawing sets of wings and building flying contraptions, which he would strap on himself in the hope of taking flight.

Along with his designs for a **parachute**, an **armored tank**, and a **helicopter**, he made some 400 drawings of military and industrial machines. His drawings have been valuable in helping us learn about the kinds of machines that existed during his time. Below is a pen drawing Leonardo made of a **catapult**, a machine used to launch an object, such as a missile, into space.
