

# Lines and Patterns

## Objectives:

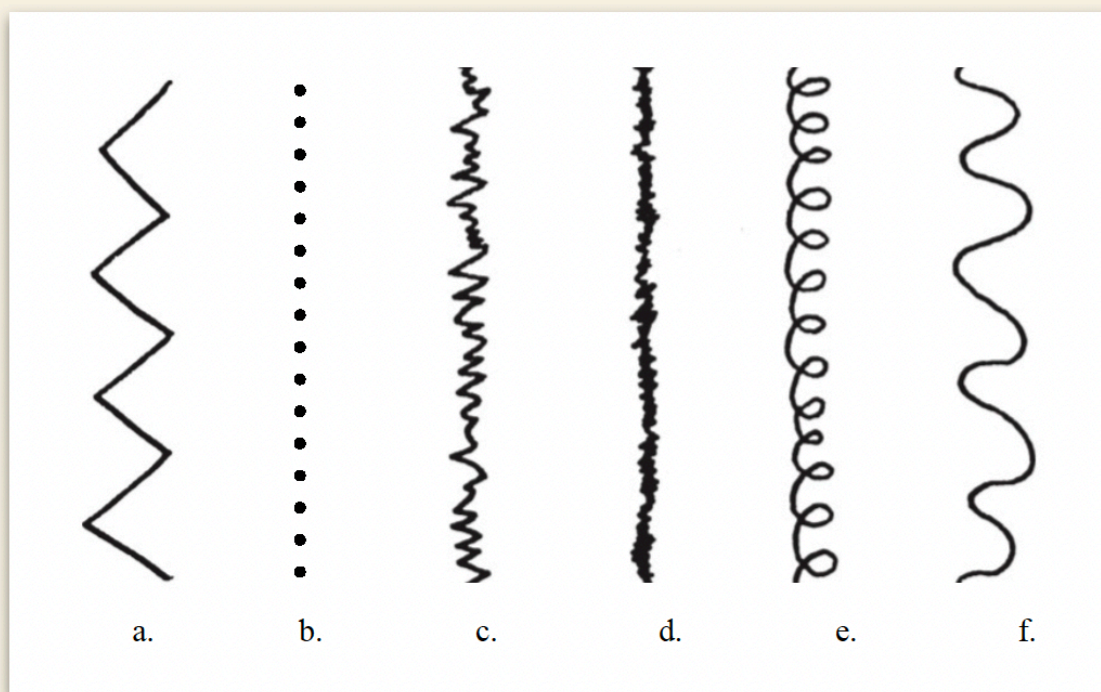
- To explore different kinds of lines.
- To make patterns by varying the arrangements of straight lines.
- To distinguish between *shape* and *line*.

## Materials:

- CHOOSE ART STUDENT BOOKLET pages 1 and 2
- Set of 4 toothpicks (or similar objects) per child
- A piece of wool

## Advance Preparation:

- Practice drawing a number of different kinds of lines. Try fuzzy, zigzag, wavy, dotted, curvy, loopy, and jagged lines. Study examples below:



a. zigzag b. dotted c. jagged d. fuzzy e. loopy f. wavy
