Scriptural Objectives For The Unit:

- To learn what it means to be “*fearfully and wonderfully made.*”
- To recognize that only God can create life.
- To create a dough person and to recognize our inability, as humans, to bring our creations to life.
- To recognize the wonder of God’s creative abilities in the perfectly formed body of a tiny baby.

Suggestions For Introducing The Scriptural Theme:

Introduce the unit by talking about the uniqueness of God’s creative power: God is the only one who can create life—no one else can. Scientists have tried, but they are unable to inject the spark that causes life. People cannot even make a leg or an arm that works as well as the ones God made for us.

Do either **or** both of the following:

- Show the children a few grains of wheat. Talk about how scientists can make grains of wheat that look just like these. They can produce all of the ingredients. But they cannot make the seed come to life and begin to grow. Only God’s seeds have life inside of them.
- Show pictures of artificial limbs and discuss how medical science has done a good job helping people who have a missing limb. But none of these limbs work as well as the ones God made for us.
