

Eyes To See

Objectives:

- To practice keen observation and visual memory.
- To use the eyes to measure and calculate space.

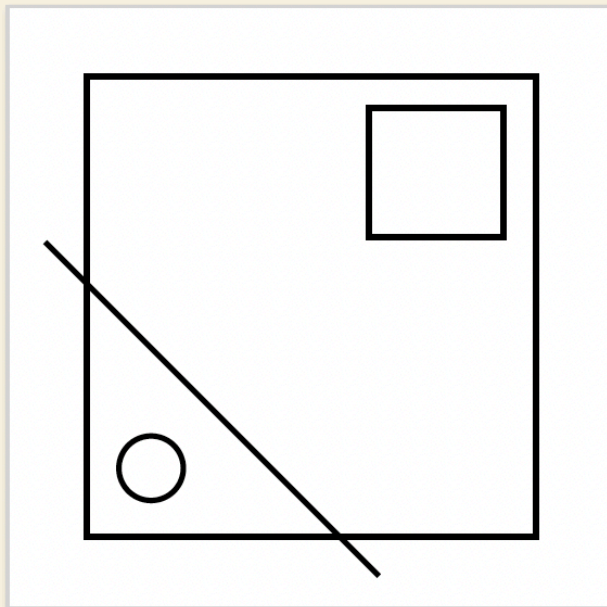
Materials:

- CHOOSE ART STUDENT BOOKLET pages 1 to 8
- 9" x 12" newsprint or white bond: 3 each/child
- Cards prepared during "Advance Preparation"
- 12 common objects such as an eraser, a toy truck, a string, a bottle, a flower, a ping pong paddle, a shoe

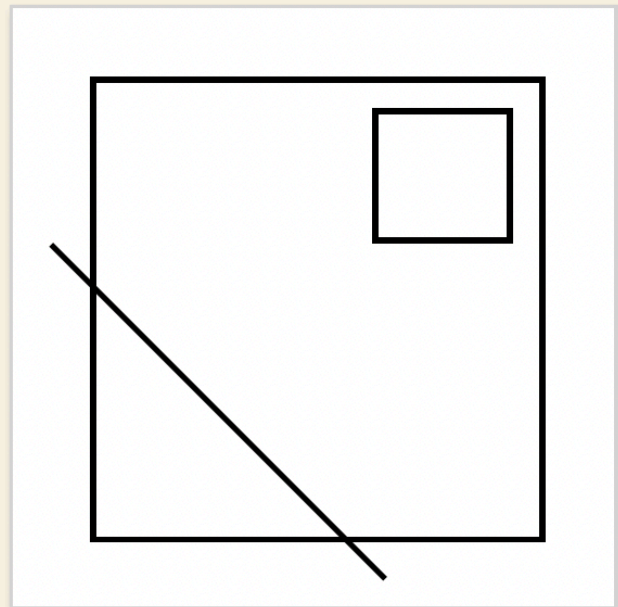
Advance Preparation:

- At the bottom of this page and on the next four pages you will find a total of 16 separate cards. The first 8 (4 sets of 2 cards each) are designed for 'A' students. The second 8 (4 sets of 2 cards each) are for 'B' students. Choose either the 'A' set or the 'B' set or both, and create enlargements of the cards. Each card within a set should be cut separately. Be sure to make the cards large enough for the illustrations to be clearly seen by all the students. Label the backs of the cards to avoid confusion during class.
