

Method:

Step 1: Scripture Talk

Read **page 14** of the student booklet.

Step 2: Procedures With Dough

Before the children remove their dough from the plastic bags in which they brought it, proceed with your demonstration based on the following information.

Shaping the body:

Shape a chunk of dough into a ball. Elongate the ball shape and lay it on a piece of aluminum foil to form the torso of the figure. Roll another ball for the head. Then roll two pieces of dough into cylindrical shapes for an arm and a leg.



Gluing pieces of dough together:

Water is all you need to glue one piece of dough to another. Simply wet the surface of

both areas to be joined and gently press them together. Join the head and the arm and leg to the body, as an example. Without water, the dough may separate when it is baked.



Designing the face:

Use the end of the drinking straw to press imprints for the eyes. Roll a tiny ball for the nose and add it with water. Make nostrils with the toothpick and prick the cheeks with the toothpick to make freckles. Use the knife to shape a curve for the mouth.
